THE HARMONY HOUSE TREATMENT CENTER IN ESTES PARK NOW HAS AN NA MEETING TWICE A MONTH; WE STILL HAVE A ONCE A MONTH SPEAKER MEETING HELD ON THE SECOND SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH. THE ISLAND GROVE TREATMENT CENTER IS GOING WELL ON THURSDAYS. WE ARE LOOKING INTO STARTING A WOMENS MEETING AT THE LARIMER COUNTY DETENTION, CONTACT HAS BEEN MADE WE JUST HAVE TO BE TRAINED AND GO THROUGH CLEARANCE. WE ARE VERY EXCITED ABOUT CARRYING THE MESSAGE INSIDE THE WALLS.

WE NOW HAVE 18 MEETINGS THROUGHOUT THE AREA INCLUDING MEETINGS IN STERLING, FORT MORGAN AND YUMA. OUR NEW NOON MEETING MON – FRI IS GOING STRONG AVERAGING 7 TO 13 MEMBERS EACH MEETING W/ MANY NEWCOMERS. WE HAVE ELECTED A NEW LIT CHAIR, NICK.

PROPOSAL

BASC REQUESTS \$248.57 FROM CRSC AS SEED MONEY TO SUPPORT 4 NEW H&I PROJECTS.

BASC IS CURRENTLY SUPPORTING ONGOING PROJECTS AND SERVICES, HOWEVER DOES NOT HAVE THE FINANCES TO SUPPORT THESE NEW PROJECTS GETTING STARTED.

OUR H&I CHAIR HAS RECENTLY BEEN FILLED IN MARCH AFTER HAVING BEEN VACANT FOR A YEAR. WE HAVE CONTINUED WITH ONGOING PROJECTS, BRINGING MEETINGS AND LITERATURE TO BOULDER COUNTY WOMENS JAIL AND THE ADAMS COUNTY MENS JAIL. THE INMATES OF THESE FACILITIES ARE ASKING FOR MORE. OUR NEW H&I CHAIR IS VERY ENTHUSIASTIC AND HAS BEEN VERY ACTIVE. WE WILL BE ADDING A MENS AND ANOTHER WOMENS MEETING AT ADAMS COUNTY JAIL. WE HAVE ALSO BEEN ASKED BY CENTENNIAL PEAKS HOSPITAL TREATMENT FACILITY TO BRING A MEETING TO THEM. WE HAVE THE MANPOWER TO BRING THESE MEETINGS IN PLACE AND ARE PROCEEDING WITH ALL NECESSARY CLEARANCES.

TO FURTHER OUR EFFORTS TO CARRY THE NA MESSAGE WE WOULD LIKE TO SUPPLY THESE FACILITIES WITH MORE LITERATURE THAN WE ARE CAPABLE OF PROVIDING. WE ARE THEREFORE ASKING FOR SUPPORT IN THIS MATTER FROM THE CRSC. ITEMIZED LITERATURE ORDER FORM IS ATTACHED.
